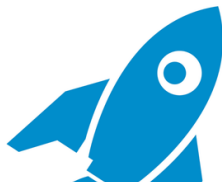

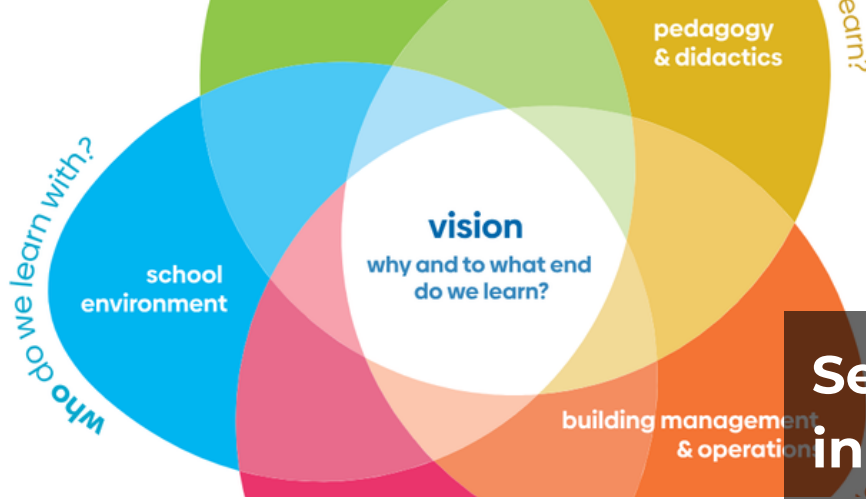

Mobility

From Eindhoven Airport

From Eindhoven Airport you can easily and quickly travel by public transport. Next to the terminal in P1 is a bus stop where you can board bus 400 or shuttle bus 401 to Eindhoven Central train station. This journey takes approximately 20 minutes. Lines 400 and 401 run several times an hour.

From Eindhoven Central train station you can travel to 's Hertogenbosch train station in about 20 minutes.

From Amsterdam Schiphol Airport

Traveling from Amsterdam Schiphol Airport to 's-Hertogenbosch takes about 60 minutes. Just take the direct train. Stay in the train for 30 minutes longer and you arrive in Eindhoven Central Station.

Cancellation

Cancellation must be reported by email. The following cancellation policy applies:

- For cancellations reported between 8 and 6 weeks before the start of the course: cancellation costs of 25% of the registration price.
- For cancellations reported between 6 and 2 weeks before the start of the course: cancellation costs of 50% of the registration price.
- For all other subsequent cancellations up to 2 weeks before the start of the course: no refund.
